The European Network of Registers of Wills Association, in compliance with the Basle Convention of <u>16 May 1972</u>, relating to the Establishment of a Scheme of Registration of Wills, enables States which have a register of last wills and testaments, to interconnect these registers. It facilitates for European citizens to discover the testamentary dispositions left by a deceased person, regardless of the country in Europe where this disposition was registered. The ENRWA also allows the interconnection of registers of European certificates of succession (ECS).

Within this framework, our vocation is to provide an efficient service of interconnection of registers, to animate the network and to communicate to legal professionals as well as to European citizens on the means of tracing a last will disposition or an ECS in Europe.

Our strategic vision has the following main objectives:

- to accomplish the mission of interconnecting last wills and ECS registries.
- to communicate and encourage the people concerned to use the register (ENRW)
- to ensure the sustainability of the association.

In order to fulfil our mission in accordance with our values, we commit ourselves to develop and continuously improve our quality management system, to mobilize the necessary resources to ensure that it is relevant and effective.

The involvement and professionalism of the staff are the main factors in the success of the ENRWA's mission.
